

# 2024-25 PE & Sport Service for South & East Area Primary Schools

The following service packages are designed following consultation with partner schools across the Shrewsbury area.

Our system works on a 3 tiered option basis, with a menu of additional services if required. We are open to discuss more individualised packages on a school-to-school basis in order to meet your every need.

# Three tiered service options 2024-25

**Gold Package:** Will have positive impact across the whole school and ensure your PE and Sport needs for the year are taken care of:

- 1. Access to unlimited inter-school competitions for the remainder of the year
- 2. Access to 3 TSA INSET opportunities for PE leads/teaching staff/Head Teachers
- 3. Access to 2 whole school INSET opportunities for unlimited no. staff \*could be shared across multiple schools, federated schools/MAT if desired
- 4. Access to Playground Leaders training for 1 cohort within school
- 5. Access to Bronze Ambassador Training and mentoring programme for 4 8 Y5/6 pupils
- 6. 1 Full day PE teaching p/week throughout the academic year from SGCo team (schools may choose to allocate some of this time towards the development of its whole school Physical Literacy strategy)
- 7. 1 after school club p/wk (delivered on nominated day)

Silver Package: Will have positive impact in your school and provide added value to your PE and Sport provision



- 2. Access to 3 TSA INSET opportunities for PE leads/teaching staff/Head Teachers
- 3. Access to 1 whole school INSET opportunities for unlimited no. staff \*could be shared across multiple schools, federated schools/MAT if desired
- 4. Access to Playground Leaders training for 1 cohort within school
- 5. Access to Bronze Ambassador Training and mentoring programme for 4 8 Y5/6 pupils
- 6. 1/2 Full day PE teaching p/week through<mark>out the academic year from SGCo team (schools may choose to allocate some of this time towards the development of its whole school Physical Literacy strategy)</mark>
- 7. 30% discount off 'GetSet4PE' online licences and resources for all teaching staff

Bronze + Package: Will support your school's basic PE and Sport provision

1. Access to 10 inter-school competitions p/year

- 3. Access to Playground Leaders training for 1 cohort within school or Bronze Ambassador Training for 4 8 Y5/6 pupils

# What does our service offer?



### **Inter-school Competitions**

You will have the opportunity to select and attend the number of events your level of SLA dictates. Events may include 'Multi Activity Days' or MAD days where a number of different sports/activities are offered on the same day. Events will take place at the most suitable venue (secondary school site, sports club/organisation site or primary school site).



### INSET

The TSA will deliver a minimum of 1 INSET opportunity each academic term. In all packages your school would have access to each of these for an unlimited number of staff, however they are mainly targeted at PE leads and Head Teachers. For Silver and Gold members we would also provide 1 or 2 whole school INSET opportunities (topic(s) decided by school) for some/all of your staff in your school setting and at a time to suit your needs.

### Leadership Training



Playground Leaders Training

Will consist of 1-day training for a class of Y5 or 6 pupils. This course equips pupils with the skills and ideas to make playground space/break times and lunches more activities for ALL pupils.

Bronze Ambassador Training will consist of 1 day training for 4—8 Y5 or 6 pupils identified by you. This course equips pupils with the skills/ knowledge to plan and deliver inter-school competitions/personal challenges. This programme will also include 3 x 1/2 day support/mentoring sessions, either to support/observe competitions being delivered and/or support BA's review and plan further events.



Teaching including CPD opportunity or PPA cover

½ day teaching to include delivery of high quality PE from 9.00am—12.00pm or 12.30pm—3.30pm to KS1 and KS2. Teaching to cover any activity within NC guidance to suit your school's needs. This can also enable team development towards competition. This could also include support/mentoring or trained Playground Leader/ Bronze Ambassador leaders during morning/afternoon break times.



1 day teaching to include delivery of high quality PE from 9.00am—3.30pm to KS1 and 2. Teaching to cover any activity within NC guidance to suit your school's needs. This could also include support/mentoring for trained Playground Leader/Bronze Ambassador leaders during morning/afternoon break times or during lunch. Gold Level also includes delivery of an after school club on the nominated teaching day. This could be targeted towards involvement in inter-school competition, a targeted intervention opportunity or a general participation opportunity.



## **Additional Extras**

# Leadership

- Preparing for transition to secondary –1 day support for Y5/6 pupils preparing them for transition to Y7 and secondary school environment (flexibility to deliver over 2 x 1/2 days and within primary and secondary setting).
- Coaching staff/teaching staff observation programme 2 days support (potential to divide into half-days) to establish and undertake an observation/support programme for school staff/ external staff delivering PE. Designated to support not critique and to improve confidence and understanding leading to higher quality outcomes for pupils.
- Active in Mind Training CPD for staff using the Youth Sport Trust's national AIM programme. AIM is a mental and physical health and wellbeing programme which utilises lessons from sport to provide meaningful, positive interventions for young people suffering mental health issues within and outside of school.
- After-school club As a Bronze or Silver club you may wish to add on an extra-curricular club throughout the year. This could be at a lunchtime or after-school to suit your school's needs and to fit in with your enrichment offer.
- Ofsted mock deep dive in PE a 1 day mock 'deep dive' inspection into all things PE, Physical Activity and School Sport from Head of Service – Chris Jew. Chris has received training from Trusted Schools Alliance and Ofsted Inspector Sarah Godden. This process will provide a 'no consequences' look into the subject area, providing a confidential summary report and advice/ guidance to work on any identified areas for improvement.
- "The PE Deep Dive helps school leaders to understand the strengths and weaknesses of the curriculum, with a forensic approach to the intent, implementation and impact of the subject. It helps subject leaders feel more confident in their Ofsted preparation for Deep Dives. It also enables school leaders to see the way in which children will be questioned about their experience of the curriculum and this is helpful to see in action! As a tool for monitoring and quality assurance, it is a great opportunity to have a subject expert look in detail at lesson delivery and impact."
